Academic Development through the British Education System: iGCSEs and A Levels

Our programme allows for individually tailored academic pathways, which students can follow as they discover and develop their academic interests and strengths.

The pre-university model that shapes our curricula encourages the development of independent learning, building up towards A Level qualifications in Years 12 and 13. A Levels were created by universities and for universities. They allow a free choice of subjects and depth of study that gives a solid preparation for higher education, certifying students' interests and their ability to pursue academic studies. A Levels also constitute a unique opportunity to lay an extensive and in-depth interdisciplinary foundation for university study.

The flexibility of choice at A Level is wonderfully liberating for students in academic terms but also a serious responsibility. A Level subjects must be well chosen, and students need to be prepared for them in order to maximise their learning possibilities. For this reason, we have carefully crafted our programmes for Years 9, 10 and 11, combining Akademeia Assessed Courses (AAC) with subjects that fulfil iGCSE specifications. All students follow core subjects that incorporate iGCSE standards but go beyond them to prepare them for A Level.

Entry points are available in Year 9, Year 10, Pre-A (Year 11) and Year 12.

PRE-A

Pre-A is a one-year preparatory programme that develops students' analytical and critical thinking skills within areas of interest and with the view of further study at A Level. The curriculum consists of five core subjects and two academic pathways.

The programme enables our students to explore various disciplines before choosing their A Level subjects. This is an entrance point for students interested in Year 11 admission.

YEARS 12 & 13

Students select three or four A Level subjects. All students in Year 12 take Academic Writing as an additional subject. They may also choose to pursue the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ), which is equivalent to 50% of an A Level.

For new students joining in Year 12, choices of A Level subjects must be confirmed by the school during the assessment process.
